2012 Summer Health Careers Institute

THE PURPOSE

- To encourage high school students with interests and abilities in math and science to pursue health careers.
- To provide these students with information and experience that will help them make intelligent educational career choices.

During this seven-day program students from all over the state will come together to explore various medical health professions as well as have the opportunity to tour health care facilities; discuss career options with professors and health practitioners; and shadow a health professional during the trip to the University of Colorado, Anschutz Medical Campus "job shadow day" in Aurora.

PROGRAM

Health Career Exploration and Education. This program is funded by a grant from The Colorado Trust foundation. The Colorado AHEC Program provides room and board, meals and all activities at no expense to the students. Housing is at a local college campus dorm setting (Colorado Christian University) with 24-hour supervision by AHEC staff, counselors and volunteers.

Applicants must be 16 years of age as of June 1, 2012 to participate in the institute. No students aged 18 or over at the time of the program will be accepted.
