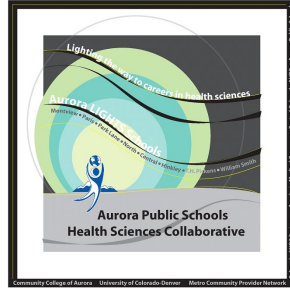


FAQ 2012 Aurora LIGHTS Saturday Academy



What are the dates? Saturdays; **Sep 10**, Sep 17, Sep 24, Oct 1, Oct 8, Oct 15, **Nov 5**, Nov 12, Nov 19, Dec 3, Dec 10, Dec 17, Jan 21, Jan 28, Feb 4, Feb 11, **Feb 22**, Feb 25, Mar 3, Mar 10, Mar 17, Apr 7, Apr 14

What are the times? We will be starting at 9:00 am each day and finishing at 3:30 pm (there are some dates that we will be taking a practice Kaplan ACT test starting at 8:00am 1/21, 2/11, 3/10, 4/7)

Do I have to bring food? Lunch will be provided each day. Students should eat a healthy breakfast before they come each day. Accommodations can be made for those with special dietary needs; however we must know of those needs ahead of time.

Do I have to pay for this program? No. All portions of this program are provided free of charge through a grant scholarship. Students meeting all requirements will receive a monetary award at the end of the program. The intent of this money is to be used for educational purpose

Can I bring friends? No. Only students who are accepted into the program may attend. Any student who brings additional people will be asked to leave for the day, except on designated parent involvement days.

What if I cannot attend all of the dates? Students accepted into the program will be required to commit to all the dates. We can make exceptions for pre-excused absences.
